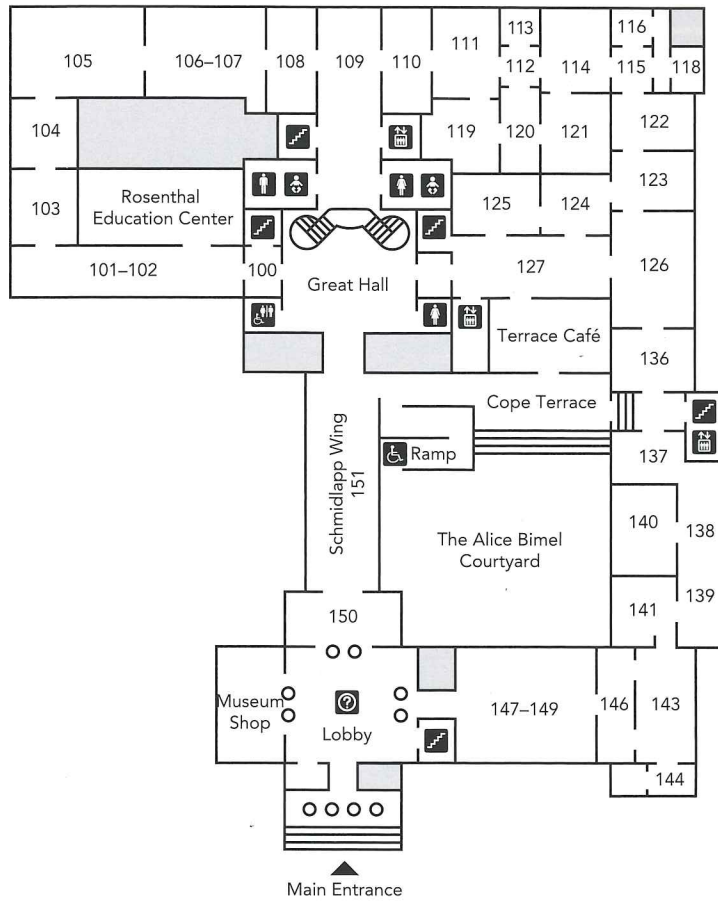
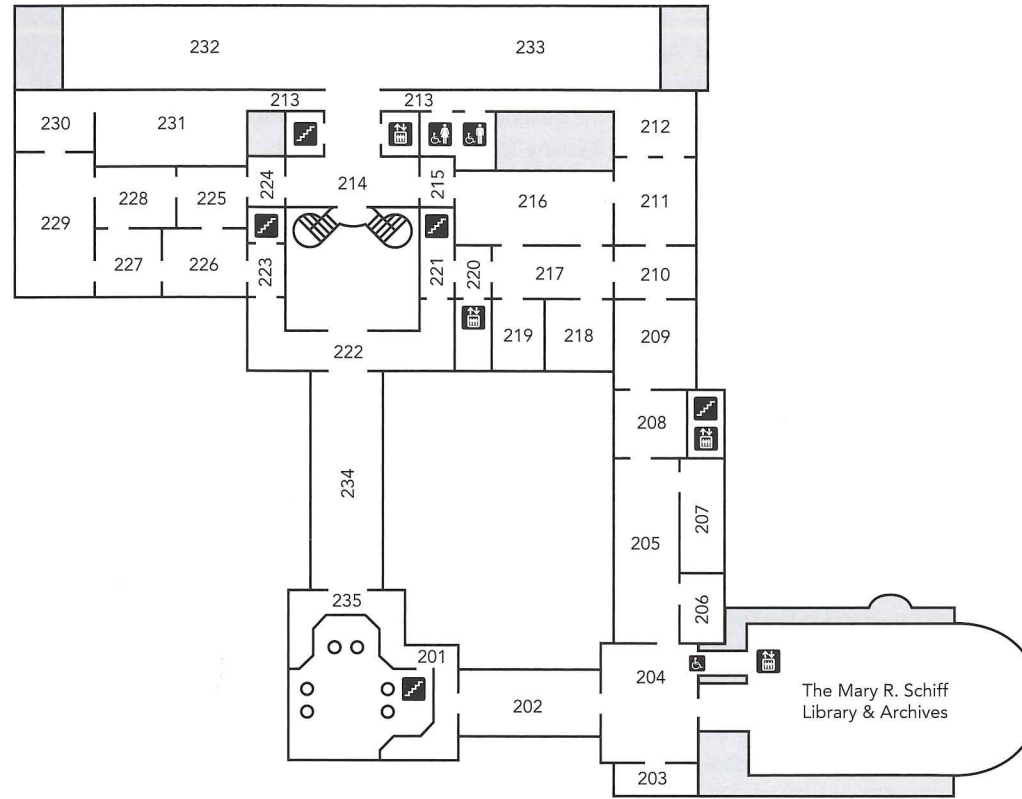


floorplan

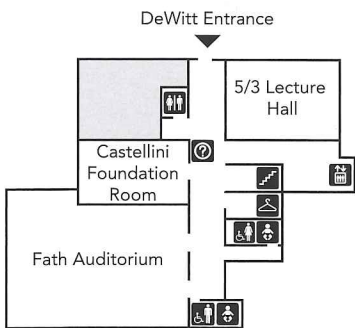
1st Floor



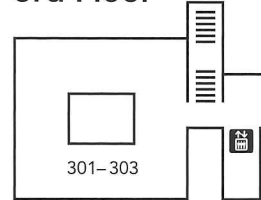
2nd Floor

The Mary R. Schiff Library

With a collection of over 100,000 items spanning 6,000 years of art history, the library is open to the public with highly-qualified librarians to assist visitors. Located on the third floor in the Longworth Wing, the library is open Tuesday–Friday from 11 a.m.–5 p.m. as well as the second Saturday of each month.

The Rosenthal Education Center
